As our Church grows, so does our need to communicate with new and existing members, as well as our local community and even an international community. We started small many years ago when Pastor Matzat registered www.zlcb.org for the Church and became the site's first webmaster.

When he retired, we still maintained the site, but it didn't expand past his original vision. That is, until Pastor Duncan arrived. Pastor's enthusiasm helped motivate many members to transition from passive membership to active membership. From a passive website to an active website. From a Church with a consistent membership to one with a growing membership.

The website has grown from a handful of pages to almost 30 pages (with a few hundred sub-pages) and from a few weekly views to over a hundred thousand page views in the last two years (and that excludes robot hits). We've added podcasts (audio recordings of the sermon), daily posts, a weekly and monthly calendar, upcoming events, videos, and important matters of doctrine, not to mention "Bible in a Year" and "Bible Memory Verses."

We now have a Facebook page thanks to the efforts of Adele Goodge. Our large photo gallery comes courtesy of Rita Sheldon. Katie Gielarowski just signed on as our VBS editor (for the website) and we're lining up school board members to manage the content for the school website. Dick Wible will be providing softball stats for our new softball page, and we don't want to leave out Elizabeth Mubarek, our Church secretary, who organizes all the content for our newsletter, calendar and bulletin. The site and its contributors continues to grow, and we're looking for other members with good ideas, or video skills, as well as those with social media experience to help us get the word out. 

COMING SOON – INFORMATIONAL SESSIONS ON SANCTUARY IMPROVEMENTS

As many of you know, late last year we established a Flooring/Sanctuary Committee to recommend improvements to the sanctuary. The Committee is close to sharing their plans with the congregation prior to scheduling a Special Voters meeting.

The preliminary plan will be presented to the congregation at various informational sessions in May. These sessions will give each member an opportunity to learn more about the planned improvements, provide feedback and ask questions. The plan will focus on a number of sanctuary improvements (like: new flooring, additional pews, etc.). These improvements are in support of last year's congregational assessment survey. That identified "Improving the worship life experience of the congregation", as the key focus area for our time, resources and investments to enhance Zion's Worship, Bible Study, Education and Youth Ministry.

The committee will evaluate the feedback from the sessions and bring their final proposal to the Church Council and Voters for approval.

Stephen Ministry Corner

Did you know Zion has a ministry available to people inside and outside of our congregation who are in need of Christ-centered care? Eight Stephen Ministers were commissioned in December after completing 50 hours of training on how to administer Christ-centered care according to the Stephen Minister's guiding principles. These principles are outlined in our Caregiver's Compass: trustworthy, compassionate, full of faith, skilled, and Christ at the center of all we do.

As Stephen Ministers, we focus on becoming care givers, not cure givers. Christ is our cure giver and we must trust in His plan and timing when navigating life's challenges. That being said, if you are facing challenging times, it can really be helpful to have a Christian you trust to share your joys and concerns with.

Another important thing to highlight is the role that trust plays in our caring relationships. All of the information shared, including the identity of our care receiver, is kept completely confidential. This allows a care receiver to speak freely with their Stephen Minister without worrying about other people "knowing their business!"

A couple of exciting things are coming up that you should know about:

In the coming weeks, we will host a "Stephen Ministry Sunday" where you'll have the opportunity to meet each of the Stephen Ministers and hear a bit more about the program. We'll also be filling the roles at that Sunday's service. We hope to see you there! It will be a great opportunity to learn more if you think you know someone in need of a Stephen Minister, or if you're interested in serving as a Stephen Minister when we have a new class of care givers trained up next Fall. It will also be an opportunity for everyone to learn more about this ministry, because we need your support to make it successful and as beneficial as possible to the people of Zion.

In October, we have volunteered to hold a Stephen Ministry informational for any congregation in the area to come and hear more about how to start up a Stephen Ministry program. A few people from Zion attended a similar meeting last year, and here we are with a successful program just a few months later! One of the coolest things about Stephen Ministry is that it is not distinctively LCMS—any church can start a program for giving Christ-centered care—but it does have its roots in the Lutheran Church! More than a million Stephen Ministers have been trained since the program's inception in 1975.

If you or someone you know would be interested in being matched with a Stephen Minister, please contact Pastor Duncan. Stephen Ministry has certainly changed the lives of your 8 minis-
