Salutation and Collect of the Day



P Let us pray.

Almighty God, grant that we who have celebrated the Lord's resurrection may by Your grace confess in our life and conversation that Jesus is Lord and God; through the same Jesus Christ, Your Son, who lives and reigns with You and the Holy Spirit, one God, now and forever.



First Reading – Acts 4:32-35

Now the full number of those who believed were of one heart and soul, and no one said that any of the things that belonged to him was his own, but they had everything in common. And with great power the apostles were giving their testimony to the resurrection of the Lord Jesus, and great grace was upon them all. There was not a needy person among them, for as many as were owners of lands or houses sold them and brought the proceeds of what was sold ³⁵and laid it at the apostles' feet, and it was distributed to each as any had need.

Epistle Reading - 1 John 1:1-2:2

That which was from the beginning, which we have heard, which we have seen with our eyes, which we looked upon and have touched with our hands, concerning the word of life— the life was made manifest, and we have seen it, and testify to it and proclaim to you the eternal life, which was with the Father and was made manifest to us— that which we have seen and heard we proclaim also to you, so that you too may have fellowship with us; and indeed our fellowship is with the Father and with his Son Jesus Christ. And we are writing these things so that our joy may be complete.

This is the message we have heard from him and proclaim to you, that God is light, and in him is no darkness at all. If we say we have fellowship with him while we walk in darkness, we lie and do not practice the truth. But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus his Son cleanses us

from all sin. If we say we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us. If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness. If we say we have not sinned, we make him a liar, and his word is not in us.

My little children, I am writing these things to you so that you may not sin. But if anyone does sin, we have an advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous. He is the propitiation for our sins, and not for ours only but also for the sins of the whole world.

Holy Gospel

P The Holy Gospel according to St. John, the twentieth chapter.



On the evening of that day, the first day of the week, the doors being locked where the disciples were for fear of the Jews, Jesus came and stood among them and said to them, "Peace be with you." When he had said this, he showed them his hands and his side. Then the disciples were glad when they saw the Lord. Jesus said to them again, "Peace be with you. As the Father has sent me, even so I am sending you." And when he had said this, he breathed on them and said to them, "Receive the Holy Spirit. If you forgive the sins of anyone, they are forgiven; if you withhold forgiveness from anyone, it is withheld."

Now Thomas, one of the Twelve, called the Twin, was not with them when Jesus came. So the other disciples told him, "We have seen the Lord." But he said to them, "Unless I see in his hands the mark of the nails, and place my finger into the mark of the nails, and place my hand into his side, I will never believe."

Eight days later, his disciples were inside again, and Thomas was with them. Although the doors were locked, Jesus came and stood among them and said, "Peace be with you." Then he said to Thomas, "Put your finger here, and see my hands; and put out your hand, and place it in my side. Do not disbelieve, but believe." Thomas answered him, "My Lord and my God!" Jesus said to him, "Have you believed because you have seen me? Blessed are those who have not seen and yet have believed."

Now Jesus did many other signs in the presence of the disciples, which are not written in this book; ³¹but these are written so that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that by believing you may have life in his name.

who proceeds from the Father and the Son,


who with the Father and the Son together is worshiped and glorified, who spoke by the prophets.



Service of the Sacrament






P Let us give thanks un - to the Lord, our God.



Sharing of Peace

Distribution

We welcome to the Lord's Table all who have been baptized in the name of the Triune God, can examine themselves spiritually and believe they receive the true body and blood of the Lord Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of sins and as a profession of their faith. If you hold a profession of faith that differs from that of our congregation, please speak to the Pastor before the start of the service before communing.

We believe the body and blood of Christ are truly present in the bread and wine.

We believe Christ offers the forgiveness of sins in the Lord's Supper, but that the Lord's Supper is not necessary for salvation.

We believe the Lord's Supper remembers the death of Christ and proclaims his death until he returns. We believe the Lord's Supper is a statement of unity in the body of Christ; we do not believe it creates that

unity.

During the distribution, you are encouraged to sing the Distribution Hymns, pray, or meditate on the words "this is my blood, given for you."

The cups at the center of the Individual Communion tray contain diluted wine for those with alcohol sensitivities.

GREAT TAKEAWAYS from Lessons 5-8

Forgiveness: Received from God, Extended to Others

LESSON 5: **FORGIVING REPEATED OFFENSES** 1. The false assumption that God grades sin on a curve leads believers to attempt to offset their sins with good deeds. 2. Four steps when someone sins against us: a) **Rebuke** the offender. b) **Allow** space for

repentance. c) **Forgive** if they repent. d) **Repea**t as long as that cycle continues. 3. <u>We do not want to degrade our Lord's sacrifice by withholding the forgiveness He died to give.</u>

LESSON 6: FORGIVING INJUSTICE AND PERSECUTION

- 1. We are responsible to obey God's command to forgive. We are to extend forgiveness whether or not they receive it.
- 2. Forgiving someone does not mean that we have abdicated justice. We have simply chosen to **return justice to God**, where it rightfully belongs. 3. God's vengeance does not constitute a senseless surge of divine rage; rather, <u>His</u> vengeance is the exercise of divine justice.

LESSON 7: **FORGIVING YOUR PRODIGALS** 1. Luther wrote that *the entire life of believers is to be one of repentance*. 2. The prodigal son was **spiritually lost** because of his badness but repented and found his place in the kingdom of God;

however, his unforgiving, older brother remained spiritually lost in his own goodness. 3. There's nothing we can do to make God love us less or more than He already does.

LESSON 8: **FORGIVING LIKE JESUS, OUR GOOD SHEPHERD** 1. Jesus demonstrated that forgiveness is **an intentional, repetitive lifestyle.** 2. It is not our works that bring us blessings—it is **Christ's finished work on the cross**. We are forgiven and restored based solely on what Christ has already achieved. 3. **When Jesus died on the cross, all of our past, present and future sins were forgiven.** 4. The lesson for us about the Shepherd's forgiveness is contained in His words to Simon: "**He who is forgiven little, loves little.**"
